

## **Submission Guidelines : *Wi: Journal of Mobile Media* (updated, May 2014)**

Submissions should be formatted in **Chicago Author-Date** style ([http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools\\_citationguide.html](http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html)). Solicited and contributed manuscripts for articles should be 5000 words in length, interviews or commentary/reports on projects 2000 and book, media, or conference reviews 1000. All contributions should be double-spaced and submitted to your issue's editor(s) as a MS Word file attached via email.

*Wi* is committed to integrating **media clips** whenever possible in its contents. Please make sure you have permission for any images, videos or sound you use. Media on which copyright is expired, or which are Public Domain, Creative Commons, etc., are fine to include but please clarify this with us through a list of sources. Please send original files for uploading onto the *Wi* server as opposed to linking to online sources such as Soundcloud, Youtube or Vimeo. This is to ensure that as long as *Wi* is online, your files will be accessible.

- - If possible, insert the media you wish to include in your Word document in the locations you would like it to appear
- - Collect all the media you wish to include in your piece into a ZIP folder
- - Name the Zip folder by including your last name, first name, as well as the title of your piece
- - Email the zip folder along with your Word document to your issue's editor(s).
- - Audio - minimum 192 kbs - MP3. Please also include a non-compressed audio file (.wav or .aiff) if possible with your submission for archiving purposes.
- - Video - Please see Vimeo recommendations for [compression formats](#). Files can be either .mov or mpeg.
- - Images - 72dpi and 1200px width, JPG preferred.

All article manuscripts will be **refereed** and only those receiving favourable recommendation will be accepted for publication.

Submission of a manuscript to *Wi* will be taken to mean that it represents **original work** not previously published, and that it is not being considered elsewhere for publication. For each paper the author must provide a 100-word abstract. These summaries should be embedded within the submission document. The author(s) must also supply a brief (25 word) bio giving name, rank, institution, institutional address, and email address.

**Copyright** of submitted materials remains solely with the authors of the work. Reproduction or dissemination of work published in *Wi* should only be undertaken with the express permission of the authors.
